



## **ADDRESS SIGN STANDARDS**

## **ADDRESS SIGNS:**

- Address numbers and letters shall be a minimum of:
  - Four (4) inches high
  - 1/2 inch stroke
  - Reflectorized on a contrasting background color. The preferred color is white letters/numbers on a green background.
- Posts used to mount addresses must be fire retardant (metal, concrete, masonry, pressure treated wooden 4 inch by 4 inch post).
- Addresses must be mounted a minimum of 32 inches above the ground (higher in snow country).
- Street names must be mounted a minimum of seven (7) feet above the ground.
- If your street address does not match the name of the road you live on, post your full address (number and street name).

## LOCATION OF ADDRESS SIGNS:

- All residents or commercial buildings shall display an address sign.
- A second address sign must be posted at the intersection of the driveway and the roadway if the address on the building is not visible for a minimum of 100 feet. This second address sign must be visible a minimum of 100 feet, both directions, along the roadway.
- Where multiple addresses are accessed by a single driveway or unnamed roadway, ALL addresses shall be posted on a single sign/post visible a minimum of 100 feet, both directions along the roadway.
- Additional address sign(s) are required when driveways or unnamed roads intersect or fork and it is not readily apparent which direction leads to the address(es).
